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**SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTIONS AT THE  
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*Kranj, June 6th 2019*

Editorial Board will consider papers in Slovenian and English language. Papers should not exceed 15 printed (together with reference list and literature) sheets. Approximate number of signs with spaces per page is 1.850.

Title of the paper is followed by authors' names and surnames. Institutional affiliation, address and e-mail address should be given in the footnotes.

**Deadline for submission of contributions is May 19th, 2019.** Papers should be submitted via e-mail: [knjiznica@nova-uni.si](mailto:knjiznica@nova-uni.si).

Papers will be presented at the scientific and research conference orally. After the oral presentation - and taking into account any comments and suggestions for improving the contributions - the participants will prepare their final contributions which will be reviewed and published in the Conference Proceedings accessible online. In compliance with the guidelines, formal academic style and scientific article layout should be used. Authors are obliged to provide grammatically correct papers without spelling or typing errors.

Reviewers will focus on following aspects:

- Contents: generally interesting theme, innovation, suitability for presentation and publication, consideration of previous findings and studies etc.
- Methodology: suitability of methods used, implementation of hypotheses etc.
- Structure of contribution: the length and organisation of the paper into chapters.
- Scientific equipment: consistency in quoting and citing of resources, footnotes, use of figures, references etc.

According to peer-reviews of submitted papers, Editorial Board reserves the right to decide whether a paper is acceptable for publication or not. If necessary the Editorial Board can require changes in the content, length or writing style etc. The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject contributions with inappropriate content or negative review.

The submitted papers should be original (scientific) contributions and should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere at the same time.



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## TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS

**The abstract** is written in third person and given at the beginning of the paper. Please do not exceed 250 words. It should be structured as follows: purpose, methodology and approach, results, research limitations, originality and practical implications. Authors can suggest up to 5 key words.

**All tables, figures and graphic presentations** (photographs, maps etc.) should be numbered, headed and cited with references to relevant sources and publishers consent.

**Headings** levels should reflect the organisation of the paper. Chapters and subsections should be numbered by SIST ISO 2145 and SIST ISO 690, that is 1, 1.1, 1.1.1 etc.

**Literature and resources** should be listed at the end of the paper in the alphabetical order according to the following rules:

### 1. Book (monographies, study literature etc.):

*Surname, N. (Year). Title of the work. Place: Publisher.*

Jambrek, P. (1992). Ustavna demokracija. Ljubljana: Državna založba Slovenije.

### 2. Articles and journals:

*Surname, N. (Year). Title of the article. Journal, Vol., No. of the issue, pages.*

Brus, M. (2008). Dve obletnici: propad Avstro-Ogrske in nastanek Jugoslavije. Pravna praksa, št. 49 - 50, str. 21 - 24.

### 3. Proceedings papers, monograph chapters, encyclopaedia or lexicon entries:

*Surname, N. (Year). Title of the article. In: Title of the work / Surname, N. (Ed.). Place: Publisher, pages.*

#### 4. Legal sources:

*Full title of the act (abbreviation). First official publication and amendments. For EU doc. add No. of the issue and date of publication if known and pages.*

#### 5. Case law:

*Full title of the court decision, Court, No. of the court decision, date and ECLI No. if known.*

Legality of use of force (Yugoslavia v. United States of America), International Court of Justice, No. 114, 29. 4. 1999.

**References to the literature and resources** should be given in footnotes at the bottom of each page. The same bibliographic data should be given as cited at the end of the contribution in the bibliography. It should be clearly evident who the author of the referenced section is from a footnote.

Basic rule:

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For legislation use abbreviations and paragraph No. If no formal abbreviation is officially used than give full title of the act. For court decisions abbreviation of the court should be given, full title of the court decision, No. of the court decision and date.
